All 4 species included (1 fox, 1 hare, 5 ptarmigan, 5 King Eiders) - Trophy handling and shipping to Denmark - Rifle rental - 6 nights of accommodation in hotel or apartment in Nuuk - Fully guided hunting with local hunting guide - Daily boat transfers to/from fjord in closed Targa boat Lunch and beverages on all hunting days - Airport transfers - All licenses and documents allowing you to shoot in Greenland and to take your guns and ammunition through customs - VAT.

#### **The price does not include:**

Flights to Greenland - Tips - Cartridges are €45/per box of 25 – Dinners & Alcoholic drinks Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

#### **Add-ons for additional Trophies:**

Large Reindeer bull: 2.500 €

Bull / Cow / Calf: 1.500 €

Seal hunting: 3.000 €

( Price includes handling and shipment to our Danish taxidermist )

( Please note that the Reindeer has no antlers in this time of the year )

Other species:

Hare: 500 € - Fox: 600 € - Ptarmigan (5 birds): 500 € - King Eider (5 birds): 500 €.

We need a minimum of 2 guns for this special trip. At the time of booking, a 50% deposit is required to confirm dates. Balance shall be paid 90 days before the shooting.

## SCHEDULE

### **Day 1 – Arrival in Nuuk:**

Upon arrival, guests will be welcomed by our local team and transferred to their hotel / apartment. Guests can then unpack, rest or shop for any last essentials. In the evening, guests will meet their guide for a full briefing on the upcoming hunting days, which will be tailored to individual preferences and weather conditions. ### **Days 2–6: Winter Hunting in the Nuuk Fjord**

Guests will experience a flexible and diverse Arctic hunt over five full days, with daily planning adapted to their preferred species and local conditions. All four species can be hunted throughout the period. Each morning, we depart from Nuuk in our heated, enclosed Targa boat. Depending on the day's target, we will navigate through steep fjords, frozen plateaus or coastal waters.

Whether we are tracking arctic foxes in the backcountry, sneaking up on hares and ptarmigans in the snow-covered hills or spotting king eiders along the icy shoreline, this is hunting at its most dynamic. We employ various hunting techniques, including porsch hunting on foot, boat-based sea duck hunting and opportunistic fox and small game hunting. Lunch, warm drinks, and snacks are provided each day.

This is more than just a hunt – it's an immersion into the raw wilderness of Greenland. Towering peaks, silent valleys and ice-edged fjords provide the backdrop for a profound connection with nature. Every evening, guests return to the comfort of their accommodation in Nuuk and a hearty dinner in the town.

## FAQ - KING EIDER HUNTING

### THE HUNT ON KING EIDER:

In Nuuk we have 3 boats (25 ft Targa's and 37 ft) with fully enclosed, heated cabs. The goal is to do 2 to 3 decoys sets per day from rock outcroppings/ islands in the path of trading Eiders. Your guide will determine where the sets will be made as you arrive in Eider country. These sets will be done over a decoy spread of 12-20 decoys and last roughly 60-90 minutes each time. Guests are also welcome to stay on the boat and hunt right from the big boat if the elements are too much.

### EIDER LIMITS:

The average bag per group of four hunters and day in the last year was around 3-8 King Eider and up to 25 common Eider...

( The limit on Eiders in Greenland is 10 per gun per day; it doesn't matter if it is Kings or Commons. Please understand that this will not be the goal each time we go afield! This resource is too precious and fragile to take that many birds, and we will not do it. )

### OTHER AVAILABLE BIRDS:

We have mostly Eiders ( King Eider and Common Eider ) in Greenland, there is also Mallards and sometimes Long Tail Duck ( but we don't hunt them often – the population is too vulnerable ) – but the hunting period for Mallards and Long Tail Duck ends end of February so if you want to hunt these species also, you have to come in February...

### BRINGING BIRDS & TROPHIES HOME:

You have the choice to have your capes & skins sent to a taxidermist in Denmark, where they can be dipped, packed and sent onwards to a taxidermist of your choice or mounted there and sent to you. The price to ship your birds to Denmark is 200 €. ( Up to 20 birds and small animals can be send ).
