Welcome to a unique hunting adventure in Sweden

1 Walked Up & Upland Shooting Day & 1 Mixed Driven Shooting Day

Shooting unlimited (Geese), Pheasant, Partridge, Duck and Hare on the walked up day & 5 Pheasant and Duck Drives with up to 400 birds on the 2nd day. During the season we can have high numbers of geese on the fields. Since it's an un-predictable hunt and we can't guarantee it, we are having it as a add on to the existing program.

Price for 8 hunters is **6.500 €** / hunter

INCLUDED:

All hunting costs & organization of the hunt – 3 nights full board accommodation for 2 guests in a double room – Rental guns – Hunting license - 25% VAT on everything

NOT INCLUDED:

Transfers from Copenhagen - Alcoholic drinks - Tips - Cartridges.

Terms & Conditions:

We need a minimum of 6 guns for this special trip. At the time of booking, a 50% deposit is required to confirm dates. Balance shall be paid 90 days before the shooting.

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SCHEDULE

14th October 26 - Copenhagen to Skane in Sweden

Arrive at Copenhagen airport. Transfer to the hotel (50 minutes). Welcome drinks and dinner.

15th & 16th October 26 - Walked Up & Driven Shooting

If we are hunting Geese, we start around 05.00 from lay blinds - Breakfast around 09.00. Rough shooting Pheasant and Partridge with pointing dogs. 12.00 - 13.00 Break and lunch at the Lodge. In the afternoon we are lifting several ponds for Ducks. Around 16.30, return to the Lodge, drinks and honoring the bag. At the driven days we have 2-3 Pheasant Drives in the morning and 2-3 Duck ponds in the afternoon.

17th October 26 – Skane to Copenhagen

After a last breakfast you depart back to Copenhagen to the airport or to a hotel in the city.



BIRDSHOOTING IN SWEDEN



Sweden is one of the best destinations in Europe for mixed rough shooting and high-volume goose shooting. What makes Sweden unique is the variety of bird species that can be shot, combined with superb accommodation.

The special landscape of southern Sweden, with its vast fields, hedgerows, forests, ponds and lakes, makes it a paradise for rough shooting. During the day, we hunt geese, partridge, pheasant, duck and hare.



Depending on the season, there can be large numbers of geese in the fields. As it is an unpredictable hunt, we cannot guarantee it and therefore offer it as an additional activity to the existing programme. Geese are hunted in the early morning over decoys on the fields, with hunters lying in lay blinds or hiding in hedges. We shoot Canadian geese, grey-legged geese and barnacle geese. This is a really great experience for passionate bird hunters.



Walked-up shooting days involve a variety of hunting methods. We walk the fields with pointers and flush hedges and ponds with spaniels. Sometimes we line up for mini drives with two or three beaters to shoot driven pheasants and ducks, or we shoot ducks in the evening. We are always accompanied by some fantastic retrievers.



ACCOMMODATION
